## OMS Cohort Effective Parish Program

The empirical data shows that there are 6 Operational Pillars that must be optimized to excellence in the most healthy and effective Orthodox Christian parishes. The research also shows that there are a total of 30 Operational Building Blocks that support those 6 Pillars.

The OMS Effective Parish Assessment 1 (EPA 1) gives a parish an assessment of its operational effectiveness in the 6 Pillars. The Effective Parish Assessment 2 (EPA 2) gives a parish a more detailed assessment of its effectiveness in all 30 Building Blocks of operational excellence.

The Cohort Effective Parish Program is not yet open for mission parishes or parishes with serious issues where a consensus is harder to achieve. Instead, the ideal Cohort Effective Parish is an innovator and early adopter parish with Clergy and Lay Leaders that are aware of the need to constantly improve their operational effectiveness.
